(Learning to Talk, Talking to Learn)

The LiTTLe Program operates in three sites within the Katherine East Region - Wugularr, Barunga & Bulman/Weemol. The Program aims to overcome learning disabilities (particularly those caused by Otitis Media) in Indigenous children from 0-3 years. Emphasis is placed on developing spoken language skills through the involvement of family and the community as a whole.

Individuals of Aboriginal descent are strongly encouraged to apply as the program has a philosophy of integrating local cultural values and practices to enable a mix of traditional and non traditional learning styles.

The Project Officer will be required to travel to communities to work as part of a team to:

- Share information, clarify values and explore options for the best way to exchange knowledge, skills and behaviours for children in the 0-3 age group and their families;
- Develop/maintain programs which address the early learning needs in each identified community; &
- Provide training and mentoring of Community Based Workers

The position is based in Katherine but requires extensive travel and, from time to time, stays for up to 5 days in remote communities within the region.
