- Fever
- Chills
- Cough
- Loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Runny nose, and/or
- Shortness of breath

Visiting Family in Aged Care Katherine



Our elders in aged care in Katherine are vulnerable to this sickness.

For now family cannot visit their relative in any of the Katherine Aged Care Facility from 15th November

- Unless they are providing end of life support and live within the Greater Katherine region.
- They must show proof of vaccine.
- Follow all directions for the Aged Care staff – sign register, temperature checks, and no more than 1 person
